A superb Louis Revival French Walnut Kingwood and Vernis Martin, ormolu mounted freestanding jardiniere / pedestal, Circa 1880 in date. The jardiniere features a decorative purple veined white variegated marble top over a bombé body with a door beautifully decorated with a Vernis Martin panel painted with an amorous couple, with landscape painted panels to the other three sides. It is raised on cabriole legs united by a lower tier, with gilded ormolu mounts throughout. Add a touch of French sophistication with this lovely jardiniere. Vernis Martin is a lustrous lacquer substitute widely used in the 18th century to decorate furniture and such personal articles as brisé fans, snuffboxes and clocks. The process of adding bronze or gold powder to green varnish was perfected by the French brothers Guillaume and Etienne-Simon Martin, hence its name...

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
