Karaja is one of the villages close to Heriz which wove beautiful rugs during the Revival Period from 1870 onwards. This is a very attractive example in a cute small size. It dates to around 1910. All the dyes are all natural and it has a very nice velvety wool quality. The weave is also quite fine. It has the ubiquitous three medallion design which is surrounded by stylised plants, leaves and intriguing geometric ornaments. The border is equally pretty with rows of stars and other geometric ornaments on a sapphire field. In excellent condition. This is a very attractive and useful antique Persian village rug which would work well in any decorative situation.
