Description

17th century low Oak coffer. Continental. Thick one piece top. The front with a moulding. Sledge feet. Original candle box/interior till. Good colour and patination. Perfect at the end of a bed or as a coffee table. This coffer is very similar to chests from the Avesnes/Thiérache area of Eastern Picardy which date from the 1650-1725 period. The mid height moulding, sledge feet and construction are very similar. In St Andrew's Church, Wickhambreaux, Kent there is a chest which bears a resemblance to these examples. Possibly the Kent chest was made in France and imported or that the chest was made by an immigrant craftsman. From 1681-1685 a large number of Huguenot refugees came to England which may explain this. This can be viewed in our showrooms in North Yorkshire at any time by appointment.
