A great example of the wild animal breed. Title "The Deer" Medium in pencil and wash on paper with a front protective glass cover. Size of the frame being 32 cm wide and 27 cm high. Signed in the bottom corner by the known British Artist J R Skeaping. This is one of his early works. Set in a traditional original frame. Circa early 20th century. John Rattenbury Skeaping, RA (9 June 1901 – 5 March 1980) was an English sculptor and equine painter and sculptor. He designed animal figures for Wedgwood, and his life-size statue of Secretariat is exhibited at the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame. Born in South Woodford, Essex, Skeaping was the eldest son of the painter Kenneth Mathieson Skeaping and studied at Goldsmiths College in London, the Central School of Arts and Crafts between 1917 and 1919 and later at the Royal Academy until 1920. In 1924, he won the British Prix de Rome and its scholarship to the British School at Rome. Skeaping was the first husband of the sculptor Barbara...

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
