The top front of the shank bears fruiting vine motifs, encompassing Medieval style initials and the bowl is aubergine shaped. Probably a commission piece due to its unique design, this superb spoon is of heavy gauge silver. Omar Ramsden is one of the greatest names in early 20th Century silver - specializing in Arts and Crafts design. Examples of his work are hotly pursued and Internationally respected.
