Unusual 17th.c. style refectory or centre table c.1900. Big enough to seat eight people as a dining table. Walnut veneered top with a deep moulded edge carved with fish scales and a straight apron below. Over a remarkable base with four legs carved as Classical inspired sphinx with female heads and claw feet morphing onto scrolling acanthus leaf spray. Resting on heavy joined stretchers with gadroon carving to the edges and raised on large claw feet. Some old marks to the top and minor wear to the base. Otherwise very good colour and condition, cleaned and waxed in our workshops. Dimensions: Width 33½" Height 30" Length 74"
