Look closely at the central tree-trunk and marvel in the beautiful natural shades of sky-blue and golden yellow. The main border depicts the continuous vine pattern symbolising the eternal cycle of life. This charming rug, made by Baluch tribes in Khorassan Province circa 1900, is in excellent condition, complete with short brocaded skirts and goat-hair selvages. Size: 1.42m x 0.76m (4' 8" x 2' 6").
