Featuring beaded bands around his neck and arms. It has a wonderful weathered patina that built up over many years yet still showing the defining features. The Khmer Empire (also known as Kambujadesa) was located in Southeast Asia on the Indochinese Peninsula. It comprised modern-day Cambodia and much of Vietnam, Thailand, and Laos.
