Godfrey Douglas Giles was born on the 9 November 1857 - he died on 1 February 1941. He was a well known artist particularly of horses & military battle images, he gained significant experiences when he served with the British Army in India also Afghanistan, Egypt and in South Africa. He also did many fascinating caricatures for magazine Vanity Fair. Captain Edward Giles of the Royal Navy who was based in Karachi was Godfreys father. Godfrey went to a private prep school in the Shires in England. He was then sent by his father to go to the Royal Military College, Sandhurst, to start his military career. H...
