Attractive and Slim Light Oak Grandfather Longcase Clock Probably by John Pepper (I) who succeeded James Pepper (II) in 1766 and was in partnership with Henry Pepper from 1773-86 and the alone till his death in 1795. His son John (II) who was born in 1769 and succeeded in the Family Business. Between 1720 & 1889, 10 members of the Pepper Family were Clockmakers and must have been a major influence on clock making in the Bedfordshire area. The 8 Day movement has 5 Pillars and an inside count wheel rather than the mass produced "Snail Wheel" Cam. Attractive Painted Dial with Gilt Decoration, Seconds Dial & Date Window.
