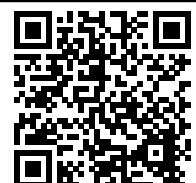
Description

K is a Kangaroo hopping along and L is a Lion, Loud, Roaring and Strong. S stands for Sheep who oft sleep in a fold and T is a Tiger, savage and bold. The images of the Lion and the Tiger suggest, perhaps quite rightly, the Potter had never seen either of them face to face. They are in overall good condition.
