A superb Art Deco silver toast rack, a lovely solid piece with good weight and classic 1930's style. This six slice toast rack is formed of flat-bottomed angular pentagon shapes raised on small stepped corners and set off with a small spear head handle. A nice clear set of hallmarks show the Edinburgh assay office marks and date mark for 1934, and also the Jubilee mark of the kings head, used between 1934 -35 to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the ascension of George V. It is also stamped with the makers name, Hamilton & Inches, Edinburgh. It is a particularly fine silver toast rack a lovely quality piece, with huge Art Deco appeal and something also for collectors of fine Scottish silver and would make a wonderful wedding present. Length 11.2 cm. Max width 5.2 cm. Height inc. handle 8.3 cm. Weight 113 grams Weights and measurements are approximate.
