The back of the spoon bowl is particularly impressive and the engraving throughout is wonderful and very crisp. All of the pieces have a cartouch to the top of the terminals with a small initial 'C' neatly engraved. Very clear hallmarks are visible on each piece for the London Assay Office, dated 1877 along with the Lion Passant and silver maker's mark: Chawner & Co (George William Adams).
