The front engraved with thistles and roses surrounding a belt vacant reserve. The back engraved with foliate scrolls surrounding a hallmarked circular reserve. Peter McGregor Westren was a goldsmith & manufacturer of Scotch jewellery and objects of vertu, he was active around from around 1880 in George Street, Edinburgh.
