An original item used at the Wedding of Princess Margaret to Antony Armstrong-Jones, this cream leather Hassock (kneeling cushion) is embellished with gold script extending to all four sides 'To Commemorate The Royal Wedding Of H.R.H Princess Margaret, Westminster Abbey, London 1960' and to the top the words Westminster Abbey, London 6th May 1960 surmounted by a gold crown. . The wedding of Queen Elizabeth II's younger and vivacious sister was a global news event and was watched by 300 million people worldwide. It was a 'fairy tale wedding' and the first time that a King's daughter had married a 'commoner' and Margaret was a hugely popular princess, stylish and intelligent, occasionally scandalous – she was ahead of her time in her understanding of the importance of the relationship between the British Royal family and the press. . The ceremony itself was attended by her family and by European Royalty, by foreign dignitaries, politicians and socialites. Westminster Abbey has been the host for numerous Royal weddings and ceremonies since 1066. . This Hassock was clearly treasured and carefully kept since 1960 and is in excellent antique condition. .
