The high white and internally clean old mine cut diamond in the centre is secured by six platinum claws in a nicely substantial 18k yellow gold shank which split at the shoulders. A great example of a classic British antique diamond ring. Accompanied by an independent jewellery report from IGR (#30310370). Cut - Old mine cut. Colour - G. Clarity - VS2. Carat - Approximately 0.40. Circa - 1905. Size - Q 1/2 (UK) or 8.25 (US). Complimentary sizing is available, can be sized up or down. Measurements - The centre diamond is approximately 4.6 x 4.6mm and sits 4.6mm from the finger. Weight - 4.25 grams. Metal - 18k yellow gold. The claws holding the diamond are platinum. Tested.
