The chairs are upholstered in a gold Chinese pattern silk mix fabric, with some marks and lighter areas due to wear but serviceable and not in need of re-upholstery. They are well padded with sprung seats and are extremely comfortable. . No worm, breaks or repairs, both chairs are very heavy, well made and robust without any weakness or movement in the joints. Both chairs have a lovely rich colour to the mahogany. . An extremely handsome and impressive pair of 19th century chairs dating from c. 1890 and hand finished with a good natural colour and sheen.
