The immaculate gilded brass case with engine turned bezel for marking the last reading with glazed view windows sat over a engraved silvered dial with blued steel pointer; hanging loop to the top. The gilded case sat in the original brown leather campaign case with securing strap to the case and adjustable shoulder strap. Bears the makers name J H Steward to the dial, a highly regarded maker of instruments who date back to the 1860's and traded into the 1970's, and who were makers and opticians to Queen Victoria's household.
