A nice period winding key. Circa 1875. Alfred Drocourt, and his son Pierre, had workshops in Paris and in Saint-Nicholas-d'Alhiermont. Pierre Drocourt was exhibiting in the 1860's and Alfred was exhibiting in 1880 and 1889 and the won may awards.
