This is a fine antique Victorian patinated bronze sculpture of the cupid hiding next to a column by Paul Ponsard, circa 1860 in date. This stunning bronze sculpture features a naked cupid depicted as a winged boy with a bow and arrow hiding next to a Corinthian column with a further cupid on top. The column is raised on a naturalistic base which is signed by the sculptor, Paul Ponsard.. This high-quality hot cast solid bronze was produced using the traditional "lost wax" process, otherwise known as the "cire perdue" method. This is a splendid antique bronze sculpture and it will no doubt become the centrepiece of your collection. Condition: In excellent condition, please see photos for confirmation.
