The ornately floral marquetry inlaid octagonal hinged top with a central star motif within borders of confronting scrollwork and birds, the cover underside with further vine marquetry, above a fitted and fabric lined interior, the conforming stem tapering through a gadrooned knob to three splayed legs with scrolled feet. Complete with working lock and key. There is no mistaking the fine craftsmanship of this handsome table which is certain to become a treasured addition to your furniture collection. Condition: In excellent condition having been beautifully cleaned, polished and waxed in our workshops, please see photos for confirmation. Dimensions in cm: Height 75 x Width 47 x Depth 47. Burr Walnut refers to the swirling figure present in nearly all walnut when cut and polished, and especially in the wood taken from the base of the tree where it joins the roots.
