A lovely snuff case by the renowned silvermaker Mappin and Webb of London. Made just before the end of Edwardian period in 1912 and the start of the Great war in 1914. It comes in an unusual oval shape with an engraved border of two circles with a pattern of dots around the very edges. The lid lifts off nicely and fits snugly back on. weighs 26.5 grams Dimensions Height 2cm Width 7cm Depth 4.8cm condition: The box is in good condition for its age. There are no dents or missing parts. There is wear and tear and patina /scratches as you would expect. It can be cleaned up with a silver cleaner or left in its original state. Inside the top there is gold gilt. The lower case has no gilding and is dark black.
