This is an absolutely super antique late Victorian/Edwardian silver plated nut dish on a pedestal foot measuring 9" (23 cms) across x 9" (23 cms) x 6 1/4" (16 cms) tall to the top of the squirrel. It's in excellent condition with super decoration all round, a gilded bowl and a squirrel sitting on the side of the dish. It has the makers mark underneath for William Hutton & Sons and is also marked Cross Arrows which was the trade mark used after the acquisition of Creswick & Co in 1900. It also comes with a pair of silver plated nut crackers though I'm not sure if they are original to the dish. Free worldwide fully insured shipping.
