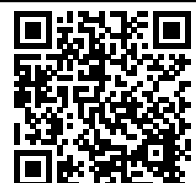

The slim case with chequered fruitwood and ebony strung edge and round base with turned cistern cover. John Davis & Son worked in Derby from 1830 until 1917 and became highly regarded retailers of instruments and later mining safety equipment. This instrument, fully restored and working.
