A very attractive, oak cased country style longcase clock by Joseph Lawley of Wellington, dating from 1810. The 8 day movement has just been fully overhauled by a registered member of the British Horological Institute. It strikes on a bell on the hours. The painted arched dial is in pristine condition and depicts a nice country scene to the lunnet with complimentary scenes to the quarters. It has a subsidiary seconds dial and date calander. The solid oak case is a lovely honey shade with quater cut timber highlighting the medullary rays of the wood. It measures ONLY 80" TALL, making it ideal for those houses that cannot accomodate many of the larger longcase clocks. Dimensions: 80" (203c.m.) tall X 18.5" (47c.m.) wide.(max)

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
