A stunning Royal Dux porcelain figurine depicting a young woman with two baskets, one in her hands and the other at her feet. The painting is done in deep matt autumnal colours, typical of Bohemian porcelain. The figurine is in excellent condition. Beautiful balance of the colour of the dress with soft undertones typical of the Bohemian school of porcelain craftsmanship. Royal Dux porcelain is a type of porcelain that has been manufactured in the town of Duchcov, in the Czech Republic, since 1853. The company was founded by Eduard Eichler, who was inspired by the porcelain factories of Meissen and Dresden. The company's name comes from the Latin word for "duke," which was the title of Eichler's father-in-law. The company's early products were simple white wares, but it soon began to experiment with color and decoration. In the 1870s, Royal Dux began to produce figurines, and by the early 20th century, these had become the company's main focus. Today, Royal Dux figurines are highly collectible, and the company is still in business, producing both porcelain wares and figurines.
