The armchairs with carved scroll arms, panelled seats, shaped forelegs and friezes, joined on stretcher bases. The backs with shaped outline open cresting rails. The two-tier table with shaped and carved bracket supports, raised on shaped forelegs joined with stretchers. A decorative set of hall or reception furniture of high quality, the dense huali timber having achieved a rich colour and patina. In excellent original condition with no damage or repairs.
