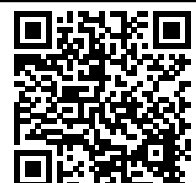

The silver lid is decorated with panels of acanthus leaves and has a vacant cartouche to the top. A cork seal is found to the inside of the lid and the lid screws down on a silver thread.
