May 1783 in Chelsea. Little is known of his childhood but, by the time he was twenty, he had acquired sufficient skill and confidence to submit a portrait of Mrs. J. Biddulph and children to the Royal Academy. His leaning towards animal subjects at this early stage of his career was demonstrated by his other exhibit in 1803, entitled 'Piggs'. He exhibited at the Royal Academy in 1806 and 1810. Over the next fifteen years he earned and consolidated his reputation as a sporting animal painter. He exhibited regularly at the Royal Academy, British Institution and the Society of British Artists. His patrons included Lord Rivers, the Earl of Ilchester and Lord Lynedock. By the time he was forty, in 1823, his reputation as a sporting painter was well established. Davis now turned his attention more tow...
