Description

A Fine Quality mahogany 8 Day Floorstanding Regulator Clock by Edwin Fisher of Bath c.1850, with a rare pull winding mechanism. The high quality case veneered in beautifully figured fiddle back and plum pudding mahogany of wonderful original colour and patination. The arched top case of typical regulator form with a fully opening glazed trunk door with the original lock and key and movement viewing doors to the case sides. The extremely well executed floral carved work beneath the dial and also to the lower section of the door with boarded false bottom and weight aperture. The backboard veneered in figured plum pudding mahogany of the very highest quality. The box base with recessed oval panel, applied carved scrolls, mounted on a plinth skirt and pad feet. The 13.75" circular engraved silvered brass dial with outer minute track and recessed subsidiary dials for the Roman hours and Arabic seconds. (Observatory markings), signed to the dial centre E. Fisher, Bath. The high quality fully restored weight-driven eight day movement with substantial and thick (5mm) tapering plates united by four heavy turned pillars secured by eight heavy blued steel screws and collets....
