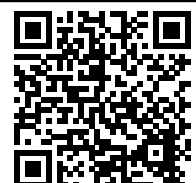

Hallmarks: Not hallmarked, which was very common for scent bottles and vinaigrette lids of this period. Both lid and grille have been tested and are guaranteed silver. Dimensions: Height: 2.5cm / 1 inch. Diameter at widest: 2.5cm / 1 inch. Condition: Good. The hinge and grille are in excellent condition. The glass body is in good condition.
