Description

This is a lovely Antique Sterling Silver Christening Cup from the early 1900s. It would be a great present for a new baby, christening or baptism and it comes in a gift bag. It was made by Edward Souter Barnsley and it was Hallmarked in Birmingham in 1907. The cup is made of Sterling Silver and has shiny sides and a rim around the top and bottom. The maker's mark and Hallmarks are on the side near the handle. On the front it has the initials ACH elaborately engraved. The Christening Cup is in good condition with the Silver shiny and a bit of tarnish and light scratches in places. There are a couple of small dents - one to the side and two to the base but these are not particularly visible. It's quite heavy weighing 113.4g. The depth of the cup is 7cm (2 3/4 inches).
