A large English Georgian antique solid sterling silver serving / basting spoon. It is hallmarked for London 1805 with the maker's marks being that of Solomon Hougham. It has been superbly made to what is termed fiddle pattern and unusually the bowl has a strainer division in place, the terminal as been engraved with the initials. It is in superb condition being free from dings splits and repairs. It measures approx. 12 inches (30cm) long by 2.25 inches (6cm) wide and weighs a very impressive 154 grams. A top quality piece.
