A beautiful antique silver George III teapot with stunning bright cut engraving. The teapot is of panelled serpentine form. W is engraved in the cartouche to one side, on the reverse side the cartouche is vacant. The hallmarked hinged lid is surmounted by a wooden finial in the form of a pineapple, the base of which is ornamented with exceptional cast sterling silver realistically modelled in the form of an oak leaf, accentuated with acorns. This Georgian teapot has a plain swan necked spout and shaped wooden handle. Dimensions, height to top of final 18.5 cm, width from handle to spout 28.cm Weight, with wooden handle 15.278 troy oz Capacity, 1100 ml.
