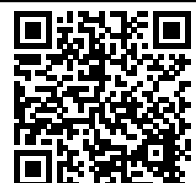

The Georgian oak settle comprises a mid-height back, with a moulded top rail and two triangular finials with four fielded panels below, interspersed by moulded rails and stiles. The sturdy down-swept arms are secured by shaped vertical supports to a solid two panel oak seat, with a straight frieze below. The oak bench stands on primitive block feet to the front and rear, all of which are united by bar stretchers, for additional strength. The Georgian oak settle frame has be...
