Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 19.5cm Rim diameter: 6cm, Foot diameter: 7.8cm. **Historical Context** Hand-blown around the time The Treaty of Hubertusburg put an end to the Seven Years' War between Prussia and Austria, and their allies France and Russia.

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
