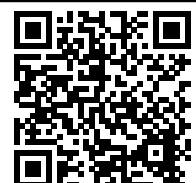
Description

This is a very well figured Irish rosewood portable book stand. The rectangular base has a single long deep drawer above the gadrooned decoration. There is a central divider and end supports of upright turned balusters. The turned carrying handles have been replaced at some stage and were made beautifully, there are still the old diagrams inside the drawer with the images and measurements for these handles. The dovetailed drawer is stamped Williams Gibton 14424 on the inside.: It measures approx 41cm w x 30 cm h. c1830/40 WILLIAMS & GIBTON, Ireland, 1829-1842 The Irish firm of Williams and Gibton was founded in 1829 and listed as "Cabinetmakers, upholsters, Auctioneers, Valuers and House agents". They evolved from the well known firm of Mack, Williams and Gibton* (1811-29) who were at 39 Stafford Street, Dublin and were appointed 'Upholster's & Cabinet Makers to his Majesty, His Excellency the Lord Lieutenant and His Majesty's Board of Works' in 1806. They supplied for some of the most important public buildings in Ireland, including the Four Courts, the War Office, the Barracks Office, Dublin Castle, the Chapel Royal and the Treasury and Viceregal Lodge.
