Description

This elaborate metamorphic beechwood artist's field easel dates to circa 1920. It is made to an amazingly clever design with many folding and sliding elements which assemble to make a full sized completely adjustable easel which can hold many different sized canvases. In addition, it has its original zinc plated steel tray for holding paints and brushes which can be drawn out for access and use and then neatly slides back into the centre when folded for transportation with a carrying handle at its top. This high quality easel is fully functional and could easily be used for its intended original purpose or alternatively, it could be used for the display of artwork or maybe as a menu holder for a restaurant. The easel is in good condition and has a very interesting well used paint splashed patination, impossible to replicate. In addition, there is a small quantity of old paint tubes which are of decorative interest. Height approximately 150cm x width 67cm x depth 110cm £495
