There are signs of age and use and it has picked up a few knocks, scuffs and marks over the years but nothing untoward and it has a good aged patina. There are some minor old shrinkage splits in the sides and a couple of old chips on the drawers but nothing detrimental. The drawers all open and close smoothly and it comes with a working key for the door.
