Born 4 July 1903, West Chittington, Sussex, son of Oliver Hall RA. Educated at Queen Elizabeth School, Cranbrook, Kent, 1914-19. He had no formal art training but studied - by copying works of landscape - under the direction of his father, launching his career as a landscape painter at the age of 15. First exhibited, as Grahame Hall at the RA, 1921 and '22. Adopted the name of Claude Muncaster, 1922 (formally changed by deed poll, 1947). First solo exhibition Fine Arts Society, 1926. Associate of the Royal Watercolour Society, 1931, and full member from 1936. Founder member of the Royal Society of Marine Artists, and later president (1958-74). Made several sea voyages, writing an...
