A handsome and very decorative longcase clock by John Berry, London. There were several makers with this name working in London in the early 18th Cent. The faux tortoise shell and japanned case has probably been refreshed at some time in the past but now has pleasing patination. The trunk door has a working lock and key. There is a hairline crack in the trunk door lentical. The possibly associated good quality 5 pillar movement strikes the hours on a bell. It has a smart brass dial with silvered chapter ring and gilt spandrels. There is a subsidiary seconds dial and date indicator. The movement looks to have been recently serviced, is in good working order and keeping good time. Free local delivery (60mils), national and international delivery arranged at cost.
