The top is hinged and opens to reveal a rich mahogany interior, to the front a bow fronted drawer with original cast brass swan neck handle with elegant back plate, the drawer is fitted with three original metal tea canisters to the front. The table stands on four square tapering legs, one of the back legs is hinged and sweeps out to support the table when opened, and all finishing with a brass cup with brass castors beneath.
