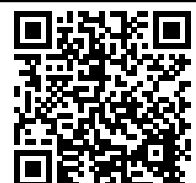
Description

This most vibrant Japanese vase is made from heavy satsuma type pottery. It stands on a flared foot with a bulbous shaped body which narrows to a small neck with a flared rim and to each side of this upper section the vase has two foliate shaped handles. The decoration is unusual it simulates cloisonne from this period. It is worked in thick raised coloured enamels over the dark turquoise ground. The complicated exotic pattern is a scrolling highly detailed foliate and flower design with four magnificent large butterflies in various positions. A most unusual large decorative Japanese pottery vase in excellent original condition with no damage or restoration. Japanese, circa 1910
