The hinged circular glass lid opens to reveal elegant Roman numerals and a splendid enameled background. The watch handle is directly mounted onto a very fine ebonised tempering shaft with its original brass ferrule. It is a lovely item and as such would be appreciated by any collector of watches, walking sticks or canes. Complete with the original keys, one to wind it, the other to change the time.
