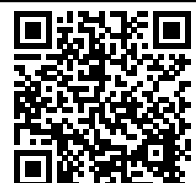

Just back from our silversmith's, it has been professionally cleaned, dents removed, re-plated and polished, restoring it to it's former glory, a small old surface blemish is visible, mentioned purely for accuracy. The underside is fully marked for the famous English silversmith, Mappin and Webb and is also lucky enough to have an English design registration number which allows us to date the design to 1932. Designed by Keith Murray for Mappin & Webb. Keith Murray (1892-1981) was born in New Zealand and moved to the UK with his parents when he was 14. He trained as an architect and worked as an illustrator before becoming a designer. During the 1930's he produced designs in glass for Stevens & Williams, ceramic for Wedgwood and for silver manufacturers Mappin and Webb. His designs are now much sort after.
