The beautifully proportioned small mahogany case of excellent colour and patination. The Chippendale style flame mahogany case with a carved mahogany swan neck pediment, glazed arched shaped door flanked by finely reeded pilasters above a carved tear drop decorated frieze. The beautifully figured mahogany triple pointed trunk door, flanked by reeded quarter pilasters above a figured mahogany base raised on ogee bracket feet. The sides of the case are also veneered in beautifully figured flame mahogany. The case is made to a very high standard using the very best materials and is in excellent original condition. The arched brass dial with gilded brass spandrels and a finely matted dial centre. The circular silvered and engraved Roman numeral chapter ring with gilded half hour markings and silvered subsidiary zones for the rise and fall mechanism and chime silent facility.
