Description

A fine 19th century oil on canvas painting depicting Hastings Castle from the beach with fishermen and boats by William Edward Webb housed in a gilt frame. Signed and dated W.E.WEBB 89 lower right. The size of the painting is 30.5 x 60.5cm; 12 x 23 3/4in, whilst overall the size is 44 x 74cm; 17 1/4 x 29in. Provenance: Property from a Private Collection. In very good ready to hang condition. Hastings Castle is a keep and bailey castle ruin situated in the town of Hastings, East Sussex. It overlooks the English Channel, into which large parts of the castle have fallen over the years. The construction of Hastings Castle depicted in the Bayeux Tapestry, showing the raising of an earthen motte topped by a wooden palisade. The castle has a fascinating history. Immediately after landing in England in 1066, William of Normandy ordered three fortifications to be built, Pevensey Castle in September 1066 (re-using the Roman Saxon Shore fort of Anderitum), Hastings (prior to the Battle of Hastings) and Dover. Hastings Castle was originally built as a motte-and-bailey castle near the sea. Later that year, the famous Battle of Hastings took place some miles to the north ...
