Description

Early C19th Italian Neapolitan gilt-wood framed pier mirror. The architectural cornice having a frieze panel below inset with a glazed Pompeiian-style fresco gouache painting. The two-piece mirror bevelled divided plates surrounded by a carved ovolo 'egg-and-dart' border. The upper mirror plate with a shaped slip edge and etched and engraved with a design featuring a basket of flowers. The plates having minor atmospheric aged degradation. The architecturally-inspired carved gilt-wood frame having atmospheric aged wear to the surface, with areas of the red gesso or 'bole' ground showing through the rubbed gilding. The verso with original back-boards. A highly decorative mirror having achieved an excellent age-worn patina and surface. H 54" W 24" D 3" Italy c.1830
