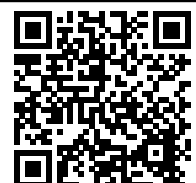

This is a great example, very early in terms of its date, dating from the Queen Anne period in fact and it has certainly survived in great condition. Clearly well cherished throughout its life, the many years of polishing, cleaning and day to day use has led to it retaining a quite glorious colour and patina that is simply impossible to replicate. Overall the condition is extremely good, just a few old marks, scuffs, scratches and dents which are to be expected on a piece of furniture which has been well used and is over 300 years old.
