The urns are decorated in the Sevres manner with panels of cherubs and bouquets of flowers reserved on a blue ground, the acanthus and floral scroll handles surmounted with cherubs to each side and raised on shaped plinth bases. Dimensions in inches: Height 1 foot, 1 inch x Width 9 inches x Depth 9 inches Sevres Porcelain traces its roots in France to early craftsmen who had small manufacturing operations in such places as Lille, Rouen. St. Cloud, and most notably Chantilly. It is from Chantilly that a cadre of workers migrated to the Chateau de Vincennes near Paris to form a larger porcelain manufactory in 1738. French King Louis XV, perhaps inspired by his rumoured relationship with mistress Madame de Pompadour, took an intense interest in porce...

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
